### **Office Hours**

- **Monday - Saturday: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm**
- **Sunday: 10:00 am to 4:00 pm**
- **Office is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day**

These rules and regulations are designed to preserve the appearance and dignity of the garden and mausoleum areas at Washington Memorial Park. They are intended to honor the lives of those memorialized here.

### **General Guidelines**

1. Visiting hours for the cemetery grounds are from 8:30 am until dusk.
2. Mausoleum visits are arranged by the receptionist at the front desk during office hours.
3. Office hours are from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Saturday, and 10:00 am to 4:00 pm Sunday.
4. Vehicles in the park shall observe a speed limit of 15 MPH.
5. Keep purses and other valuables locked in your trunk.
6. All trees, shrubs and plantings are the property of Washington Memorial Park. Plantings by individuals are not permitted.
7. Pets are not allowed in the park, except for trained guide dogs or when kept in automobiles.
8. Funeral flowers will be removed from the cemetery five days following services.

### **Memorial Gardens**

1. Floral receptacles shall not be placed on any plot unless first approved by the cemetery authority, and when placed, shall remain subject to the rules and regulations of this park.
2. No enclosure of any kind shall be permitted around any plot or lot. The placing of articles such as balloons, pinwheels, planter boxes, souvenirs, photographs or preserved flowers is prohibited and will be removed and disposed of by park personnel.

3. Fresh cut flowers are allowed in the park at all times in regulation vases. They will be removed when they become unsightly.
4. Artificial flowers are only permitted during non-mowing season. Any artificial flowers that are placed on graves during mowing season will be removed and disposed of by park personnel.
5. Permanent vases are available for purchase through the office and will be installed by the cemetery authority.

**Mausoleums and Columbariums**

1. Urns, inscriptions, name plates, fittings, and adornments for crypts or niches shall not be placed unless first approved by the cemetery authority. If permission is not received, they will be removed and disposed of by park personnel.
2. Fresh cut flowers and artificial flowers are allowed at all times in regulation vases. They will be removed when they become unsightly.
3. As a courtesy to others, please limit the size of floral arrangements so they do not encroach on adjoining crypts and/or niches.

**Maintenance Requests**

We strive to maintain the cemetery at all times. If your grave space, memorial or vases require maintenance, contact our staff at (206) 242-1787. Or, you may stop by the office and fill out a Service Request Form.
